Seminar Speakers

Dr. Richard McCaslin

"The Post-War Career of J. B. Polley"

Former Professor of History at the University of North Texas, Rick McCaslin is now the Texas State Historian and the Director of Publications for the Texas State Historical Association. J.B. Polley was very young when he joined up with the 4th Texas Infantry of Hood's Brigade. His memoir of his army service, Hood's Texas Brigade (1910), is considered one of the classics of Civil War literature.

Jeff Hunt

"The Road to Bristoe Station"

Jeff Hunt is the Director of the Texas Military Forces Museum at Camp Mabry in Austin, the official museum of the Texas National Guard. He also serves as an Adjunct Professor of History at Austin Community College, where he has taught since 1988. Part of the presentation will cover the decision to transfer Longstreet Corps and the Texas Brigade to Georgia.

Edward T. Cotham

"Damn the Torpedoes! How a Small Company of Men from Port Lavaca Revolutionized Naval Warfare"

Ed Cotham is well known in historic circles for his many books focusing on the history of Galveston and Sabine Pass. His latest work is *Rockets, Tanks, and Submarines*, and in our talk he takes a "deep dive" into the Singer family of Port Lavaca and their exploits. You won't have heard these details anywhere else!

Dr. Richard Selcer

"Taking Another Look at Robert M. Powell:
A Colonel in Hood's Texas Brigade."

Dr. Richard Selcer, Fort Worth historian and author, graduated from Austin College and TCU. He has taught in the far corners of Academia, including South Dakota, Austria, and Ukraine. He has published 16 books and more than 50 articles in magazines and journals. Colonel Powell, the intriguing topic of his talk, will be published in the SWHQ.
